Forward

As a tool for local departments of social services, the Office of Health Insurance Programs (OHIP) has compiled two listings of directives Administrative Directives (ADMs), Informational Letters (INFs), General Information Systems (GIS) messages and Local Commissioner Memoranda's (LCMs) issued by the Offices and Divisions responsible for the Medicaid Program. One list is presented in numeric order by year, and the second is a listing by subject matter in alphabetical order. The lists include ADMs issued since 1974 and INFs, GIS's and LCM messages issued since 1996.

The numeric listing includes each of the above referenced items in chronological order, beginning with the most recent year; ADMs are listed first for each year, followed by INFs, then GISs and LCMs. In the subject matter list, directives appear chronologically by year, beginning with the most recent year. In both listings, the "FIND" feature (under EDIT on the toolbar) can be used to find a specific directive.

This list is not intended and cannot be used as the final legal authority for Medical Assistance policy issues. For authoritative use of a directive, the eligibility worker should refer to the actual document. This list is only a reference tool for the eligibility worker.

NOTE:

- Directives issued between 1996 and 2011 can be found on the Department of health website.
- Directives issued between 1990 and 1996 can be found on the Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance website.
- Directives issued prior to 1990 are not available online. These directives should be available in the local district's "library".
