MaBel Subject: MBL Screen value changes

Affected Budget Type(s): All

Reason for Change

Current MBL workbook screen sizes are too small to accommodate larger data values being input into the system. Therefore, the resulting output screens truncate the resulting dollar values and the worker has to use multiple lines to account for the correct income and resource information on cases. The MBL screen paint program needs to be modified to accommodate the larger data values.

Change in Procedure/System Processing

The changes to the Workbook screen for MBL budgets with Effective FROM Dates of 11/01/2010 or greater, will allow for the entry of increased dollar amounts for the data elements listed below along with expansion of their respective screen values on the applicable budget output screens.

MaBel Subject: MBI-WPD Addition to MA SSI Budget Screen

Affected Budget Type(s): 04, 05, 06 and/or 08

Reason for Change

This is a Department initiative to assist the Medicaid worker by automatically displaying the MBI-WPD Eligibility calculation on the MA SSI output screen for all SSI-Related cases.

Change in Procedure/System Processing

For MBL Budgets with an Effective FROM Date of 11/01/2010 or greater, the MA SSI output screen has been modified to always reflect the MBI-WPD eligibility for the case. The MBI-WPD Expanded Eligibility code (EEC) values of "V" and "W" as well as the system's edit requiring the EEC Values of "V" or "W" for budget type 04, 05, or 06 will be disabled as of 11/01/2010. All other edits in regard to the MBI-WPD program calculation remain in effect.
