

A forthcoming Administrative Directive will describe in detail what districts must do to comply with the terms of the recently settled DOE v. Doar court case involving budgeting of TA households containing an SSI individual. The CNS reason codes listed below will become available on October 22, 2007 to support districts' efforts in notifying clients of actions affecting their cases.

The use of any of these reason codes will cause the Client Notice to be printed in both English and Spanish, irrespective of the stored case Language Indicator value, in accordance with the provisions of the DOE v. Doar decision.

The language associated with reason code B89 has been revised. All other reasons listed below are new.

Generally, these reason codes have been designed to function within CNS to provide required notification specific to the DOE v. Doar decision. As such, they should be used in CNS together with other valid TA case reason codes entered on WMS. Exceptions are marked with an asterisk. Codes for these transaction types may also be used on WMS.
