Dear MA Directors/TA Directors:

At the Medicaid Technical Advisory Group (MTAG) Conference Call on December 19, 2007, Upstate districts were advised that a new Reason Code, C65 (Not a Resident of District-New Address Provided MA/FHP) and a revised Temporary Assistance Reason Code M62 (Moved Out of District-TA) would be available for use on January 2, 2008. Use of these codes would insure the transitioning of a Medicaid/Family Health Plus case to the new district of residence when an individual reported a move to another district and provided an address in the new district of residence. At the MTAG call, districts were asked to hold off processing any reported moves received between December 28 – December 31, 2007 until January 2, 2008 when the new codes would be supported.

This is to alert districts of a delay in the availability of C65 and M62 until **Monday, January 7, 2008**. Due to this delay, districts are advised to hold off performing the closing transaction of a case that reports a move between December 28, 2007 and January 4, 2008 until the new/revised Reason Codes to support the transitioning of coverage are available on Monday, January 7, 2008. Interim system instructions for county to county moves will be issued later in the week.
