

A new closing reason has been created for Temporary Assistance: **M61 - Moved Out of District-Late Report**. Districts should use M61 to close TA cases that have moved out of their district two or more months in the past.

M61 will result in the following TA CNS language:

This is because the social services district must provide assistance to eligible people who:

- live in the district; or,
- don't live in the district any more but are still the district's responsibility; or,
- have an emergency need while in the district even if they live someplace else or are the financial responsibility of another social services district.

You have told us that you moved in (Month, Year).

Since you do not live in this district, and, you are not the financial responsibility of this district, and you don't have an emergency situation, you are not eligible for public assistance from this district.

If you want to find out if you can get public assistance, you must apply in the district where you live.

This decision is based on Department Regulation 311.3.

When preparing the CNS pending notice, workers are prompted to enter the month and year that the client moved in MMY format. A CNS edit requires that the month of move be more than one month prior to the current month. At data entry of the closing transaction on WMS, workers must change the address on screen one (WKUM01). This address change requirement is enforced by edit 1223 - ADDRESS CHANGE REQUIRED.

M61 - Moved Out of District-Late Report will include Medical Assistance language in accordance with provisions of the *Luberto v. Daines* court decision.
