Dear WMS/CNS Coordinator:

The purpose of this letter is to provide an explanation of the WMS/CNS enhancements that are scheduled to become operational on the Production System on February 16, 2010. This is in addition to the changes sent on January 20, 2010.

To enhance the functionality of many CNS Undercare and Discontinuance notices, we have reprogrammed the community notices to pull the financial data from the current stored MBL budget. In addition, due to the changes in resource requirements many messages were removed from notices for S/CC and FNP Parent notices. For FP notices, these resource messages remain in place for SSI-Related individuals and there is a statement that reads: If your eligibility is based on your being certified blind or certified disabled, your resources will be compared to the Medicaid resource limit.
