Addition of Lien Indicator to WMS Clearance Report

To comply with the change in lien requirements, Social Services Districts (SSD) have been required to produce and mail to property owners a biennial accounting of all Temporary Assistance (TA) issuances and recoveries assigned to a household. To assist the SSD to identify these Individuals, a New Lien Indicator field will be added to the Clearance Report. This new field will be identified as "LI" and will be displayed on the sixth line of the header between the "M" field and the "MA" field.

If a Lien exists on the Lien Account Screen, one of the following codes will appear under the Lien Indicator (LI) heading on the Clearance Report:

- LA = Lien Active
- LS = Lien Satisfied

Section II

New SNAP IPV Indicator Added to Clearance Report

A New SNAP IPV Indicator will appear on the WMS Clearance Report on the Applicants demographic line to the right of the Individual's Date of Birth. This indicator represents a nationwide search of the eDRS (Electronic Disqualified Recipient System) to identify individuals with a SNAP IPV. Results of this search will be identified by one of the characters listed below.

- **Y** - Indicates one or matches were returned from the eDRS match
- **N** - Indicates no match records were returned that matched the data entered for the Individual
- **(-)** - Indicates no eDRS match was made due to the web service not being available

A Dash (-) indicates the eDRS match was not performed because the client did not apply for SNAP benefits.
