

Section I – HEAP Indicator on WMS Clearance Report

A two-character field “HEAP” will be added to the WMS Clearance Report to identify cases that have received a HEAP benefit in the previous 12 months. If a HEAP Payment Type is displayed in this field, a determination must be made to ensure that a Standard Utility Allowance (SUA) is included in the SNAP budget. If the case received more than one HEAP payment in the previous 12 months, only one payment will be displayed on the WMS Clearance Report.

If the HEAP Payment service is inactive, an asterisk will be displayed in the HEAP field.

Section II – Addition of Edit – 1665

An edit will be invoked for Case Types 31 and 32 if the original TO Date of a Payment Type 96 (FS Ongoing Benefits) is not shortened when a void payment line is written and there is a newly written Payment Type 96 with overlapping TO Dates.

If there is an overlapping TO Date when a void payment line is written, Error 1665 – PAYMENT LINES MUST NOT OVERLAP will be generated.

1665 – PAYMENT LINES MUST NOT OVERLAP

Payment TO Date lines overlap. Must shorten existing payment line TO date.

Section III – Removal of Title on WMS Screen 4

The title “Resident Alien Program Information” will be removed from WMS Data Entry Screen 4 and from WMS Case Comprehensive Screen 4.
