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The following CNS changes will be effective by 6/1/18:

Section I: Language for H2W and H3W

Opening reason codes H2W and H3W are used by Upstate districts to authorize coverage in WMS for individuals transitioning from the NY State of Health. Both reason codes generate notice language designed to collect information required by the local social services district to determine ongoing eligibility. Modifications were made to the first three bullets, question #4, question #10 and the signature section located on the "Important Instructions – Please Read" section.

Section II: Four Notices to Address Transfer of Assets

Language for S68/X0227, S69/Y0029, S73/X0033 and S76/X0034 address Medicaid recipients who have made a transfer of assets for less than Fair Market Value. The list of services have been updated for all four notices. S68 has had references to Family Health Plus removed. S68, S69 and S73 have had the term Medical Assistance changed to Medicaid.

Section III: Resource Level Changes in Administrative Renewal Notices

Language for upstate Administrative Renewal Notice C29/796/U0218 has been updated to reflect the 2018 Resource levels for a single individual (\$15,150) and a couple (\$22,200).

Section IV: Revision of Upstate Paragraphs to Reflect Current NYS Medicaid policy that DACA Individuals Continue to be Covered as PRUCOL

Language for S77/Y0051, S78/Y0057, S79/Y0058 and C22/Y0052 have been updated to reflect the current NYS Medicaid policy that Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) individuals continue to be covered as PRUCOL despite expiration of their Employment Authorization Document (EAD).
