

Section I – Reinstatement and Modification of WMS Edit 0315 – Highest Degree 8 Not Allowed

Entry of Highest Degree Code Value “8” – Unknown, will be allowed for Case Types 31 and 32. WMS will accept a value of “8” in the Highest Degree field but not allow entry of a value of “8” - Unknown in the Highest Degree field for Case Types 11, 12, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 and 60.

Entry of Code Value “8” in Case Types 11, 12, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 and 60 will result in Edit:

0315 – HIGHEST DEGREE 8 NOT ALLOWED

Section II – Payment Type NX - Nominal HEAP Benefit on Cases with Emergency Indicator X

Payment Type NX – Nominal HEAP Benefit, will be required in Case Types 11, 12, 16 or 17 when the Emergency Indicator is equal to X. Payment Type NX conditions must be met to receive this benefit. Please refer to the Dear WMS/CNS Coordinator Letter dated March 23, 2018 for an explanation of the Nominal HEAP Benefit – NX.

Edit **1678 - PAYMENT TYPE INVALID WHEN EMERGENCY IND EQUALS X** will be set when an NX payment is written on Screen 6 on WMS. This edit must be overridden.

New Edit:

1678 PAYMENT TYPE INVALID WHEN EMERGENCY IND EQUALS X

Payment Type NX is not allowed if Emergency Indicator = X
This is an overridable edit

Edit Modification:

Payment Type NX will be removed from edit # 0797.

0797 - PAYMENT TYPE INVALID WHEN EMERGENCY IND EQUALS X

If Payment Type is A1-A3, L1-L3, M1-M9, P1-P9, 19 or 24, then Emergency Indicator must *not* be X. (F, E, U)

Section III – Payment Type NX – Nominal HEAP Benefit during FS Separate Determination

Payment Type NX – Nominal HEAP Benefit, will be allowed when the FS Separate Determination case is opened at TA Closings with transaction types 03, 07 or 08. Payment Type NX edits will be applied during the FS Separate Determination process. If an NX Payment is authorized during the FS Separate Determination process, WMS will not search the TA Authorization Payment History to determine if a previous NX payment was issued. The Authorization Payment History for NX payments will only be applied to the FS Separate Determination case.
