<p>Q. We use a provider report to identify cases that transition from NYSOH to WMS. What can we use?</p>	<p>A. There is a daily Mobius report that is available to districts to identify cases coming back from NYSOH:</p> <p>BMDP5160, WMS Upstate Takeover of HBE PCP Clients BMDP5161, NYC Takeover of HBE PCP Clients Report</p>
<p>Q. Suffolk County uses the roster to create reports. What are alternatives to obtain the information previously provided on these reports?</p>	<p>A. The Medicaid Data Warehouse (MDW) would have enrollment information</p>
<p>Q. NYC will sometimes temporarily take out an enrollment to put up Medicaid eligibility retroactively and then reenter the enrollment line after the eligibility transaction is complete (could take a few days). Can you confirm that if this action is completed by the 25th of the month, the plan won't receive a term?</p> <p>For example, there is currently 10/1/20 Medicaid eligibility and a 12/1/20 managed care enrollment for Paul. On 2/5/21, the LDSS is told that they need to put up Medicaid eligibility from 8/1/20 on this consumer. In order for NYC to enter the 8/1/20 Medicaid FFS eligibility, they need to take out the 12/1/20 managed care enrollment line. On 2/10/21, the 8/1/20 Medicaid eligibility has been entered and NYC has reentered the 12/1/20 managed care enrollment line. What will the managed care plan receive?</p>	<p>A. The exceptions to the Terminator process (25th of the month file) includes members with identified by the LDSS as deceased, when the eligibility and/or enrollment is retroactively end dated, when there is a coverage gap between current and prospective enrollments with the same Plan.</p> <p>The plan will receive:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. a CANCEL transaction for 12/1/20 immediately following the WMS deletion entry 2. an ADD for 12/1/20 immediately following the retroactive WMS enrollment entry <p>The LDSS should notify the Managed Care Organization (MCO) in advance of retroactive actions impacting eligibility and/or enrollment.</p>
